

# Ewart finally gets his show on TV

Beginning in July there will be 13 shows on KVOS on Sundays with repeats airing the following Saturdays.

When he was toiling on the Asian golf tour without much success a few years ago, Brad Ewart used to perform trick shot exhibitions as a way of paying the bills.

His signature shot is performed on one knee with the ball teed on a stick at waist level. Ewart swings his driver like a baseball bat and knocks the ball about 220 yards straight down the middle of the fairway.

It's a tough shot that has taken hours of practice to perfect, but Ewart will tell you it's not nearly as difficult as the process he's just gone through.

For a couple of years now, Ewart has attempted to get a locally produced golf show on TV. Finally, after overcoming more hazards than any golf course can throw at you, it looks like he's succeeded.

*The Golf Show* makes its debut at 4 p.m. Sunday, July 5 on KVOS (Channel 12). It's been a labour of love for Ewart.

That's a good thing, because Ewart says no one involved in the 13 shows that will air this summer is going to get rich off the project.

"I've lost more than 20 pounds trying to get this show to air," says Ewart, who in his other lives serves as director of marketing at Westwood Plateau and media relations manager of the Greater Vancouver Open.
